

Prayer at the Heart - NE Ohio Pilot – Latest News – Week 3

Forty days of prayer, care, and share enters its third week at Tents of Meeting (TOM) set up at ten locations throughout northeast Ohio. In the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 10, Jesus commands his disciples to "proclaim the gospel" and conduct ministry "Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons". The two go hand in hand ... the Gospel plus ministry! The Tents of Meeting are places where the hurt and broken can come and experience God's love. It is a place where they can receive ministry and be presented with the Gospel in an honest, non-judgmental, and non-coercive way.

The Tents of Meeting are staffed by volunteers who seek to glorify God by sharing the love that they have received from Jesus. Christians from different parts of the Church – Evangelical, Pentecostal, Catholic, African America, Latino, Caucasian etc. are working together to proclaim the gospel and meet needs. In the past two weeks dozens, perhaps hundreds of people have received Jesus' free gift of salvation. Many have been healed of various ailments and still more delivered from strong destructive addictions. Repentance, forgiveness, and reconciliation is being experienced and genuine peace and joy has been achieved or regained by many.
