A MOVEMENT OF HOPE

Solemn Assembly in [location] 2024

Focus:

We are humbly coming before the King of Kings, the God of Heaven and Earth to confess our sins and to solemnly commit to express our love for Him by obeying His commands (John 14:21-23).

Welcome:

Preparation in Worship:

Biblical Vision: A leader to outline our hunger for God's presence and glory to fall over the [community, workplace etc.] resulting in a great awakening with salvation, healing, deliverance, forgiveness, reconciliation...

A recognition that we have not followed God's commands as given in the New Testament to:

- **Be in unity in radically loving one another as a priority ahead of our doctrinal differences** (2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 133:6, John 13:14-15, 17:21-23);
- **Earnestly pray together as Jesus taught us, to exalt His name and cry out for His Kingdom to come in our [community, workplace etc.]** (2 Chronicles 7:14, Isaiah 62:6-7, Matthews 21:13, Luke 10:2-3, 11:2-4); and
- **'Go' to our communities and workplace, to be His hands and feet in sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ in word and action to 'Lost and Broken' people.** (Matthew 28:19-20 Christians carry God's light and His light drives out the darkness when we 'Go.' Matthew 5:14 & 16, Luke 9:1-6, 10:1-18).

To thank God for His grace to carry out His will (Hebrews 13:20-2, Acts 1:8, 2 Corinthians 12:9).

To thank God for the examples in scripture and history of great awakenings when Christians obey his word.

To pray for ears to hear and eyes to see what God is doing and the courage to obey His call.

Response:

- Prayer in triplets: Thank the Lord for his promise to be with us as we pray (Matthew 28:20) and ask him to shape our prayers to reflect his will. (1 John 5:14)
- Opening pastoral prayer

Repentance: [A leader gives overview]

Response:

- Confess our failure to wholeheartedly love God – **[choose someone to lead each of these segments]**
- Confess our failure to love and unite with other believers – [.]
- Confess our focus on theological differences that have kept us from loving other believers. [.]
- Confess our failure to love our neighbors as ourselves – [.]

Commitment: [A leader gives overview]

Response:

- Prayers of commitment to love, serve and work with other Christians where God has planted you – where you live, work or go to school – **[choose someone to lead each of these segments]**

- Prayers of commitment to pray with other Christians where God has planted you – where you live, work or go to school. []
- Prayers of commitment to be a witness for Christ to ‘Lost and Broken’ people, with other Christians, where God has planted you – where you live, work or go to school. []
- Prayers of commitment to start 30 Minute Prayer Challenge groups (30MPC) where you live, work and go to school.

Prayers for Revival in the Church – [A leader gives overview]

Response:

- Pray for a great spiritual hunger in the Church for Jesus and His Kingdom to come. (Psalm 107:9, Luke 1:53, Matthew 5:6, Philippians 3:10-12).
 - Pray for the Holy Spirit to pour God’s love into our hearts that we might love Jesus with all our heart, mind and soul. (Matthew 22:37).
 - Pray for strength in our inner being to comprehend the full dimensions of Christ’s love. (Ephesians. 3:17b-19)
 - Pray for ears to hear and eyes to see what God is doing. (Luke 10:23-24, Ephesians 1:17-18)
 - Pray that the love of Christ will compel every Christian to lay their life down for God’s will, to unite, pray and reach out to ‘Lost and Broken’ people. (2 Corinthians 5:14-15, Matthew 4:19).
 - Pray that Christians will love each other as Christ loves us – to love and serve one another, to pray for one another, to be patient and kind to each other, to always speak well of each other, to support and encourage each other, to forgive each other and to hold no record of wrongs!
 - Pray for courage for pastors, ministry leaders, and every Christian to say ‘yes’ to what God is saying and doing in our day for unity, prayer and outreach (2 Chronicles 7:14, John 17:21-23, Matthew 28:19-20.)
 - Prayers for personal and corporate revival (in groups of 6)
- Congregational Worship in song:

 - Love every fellow believer in Christ in word and action (John 13:35);
 - Pray a minimum of 30 minutes a week with Christians in my community, workplace or school;
 - Share God’s love in word and action with the people in my community, workplace or school (Acts 1:8; Eph. 4:15,16) –
